## Transition Scholarship Application

Transition Scholarships acknowledge the academic achievements and leadership qualities of exceptional Year 6 students.

Scholarship recipients also typically demonstrate active involvement in all aspects of school life and in the wider community.

Scholarship funds are credited towards the students Semester 1 Year 7 Text and Resource Scheme. Any surplus funds can be used towards other school-based expenses, including: uniforms, excursions etc.

Students may re-apply in May for the financial year scholarships which are available to students in Years 7—11.
